EVERYDAY ENEMIES THAT THE BELLS OF JESUS' JOY CAN OVERCOME

I. OFFENSE

- -Who or what has recently offended you?
- -In the same way a SPD officer wears a bulletproof vest to **guard** his heart, we must remember to put on our prayer vest to **guard** our heart against offense.
- "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, PRAY for those who mistreat you." Jesus, Luke 6:27-28 NIV

Ring the Bells of Jesus' Joy:

- 1) Don't Seek Revenge (Leviticus 19:18)
- 2) Be Gracious
 - "Let your conversation be always full of GRACE." (Colossians 4:6a)
- 3) Deal with Offense Biblically (Matthew 18:15-16)
- 4) Humbly Look for the Kernel of Truth
- 5) Forgive

"FORGIVE as the Lord forgave you." (Colossians 3:13b NIV)

II. JEALOUSY

-How do you react when others succeed and you don't?

This made Saul very angry. "What's this?" he said. "They credit David with ten thousands and me with only thousands. Next they'll be making him their king!" So from that time on Saul kept a JEALOUS eye on David. 1 Samuel 18:8-9 NLT

Ring the Bells of Jesus' Joy:

- 1) Express Gratitude
- 2) Celebrate Others

III. CYNICISM

- -When people look up the definition of cynicism, is your name noted?
- -JOY disrupts cynicism: Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." John 1:45 NIV
- "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" John 1:46 NIV
 - ◆ 50 Salvation Decision!
 - ◆ 15 Water Baptisms!
 - 36 First-time Financial Partners!
 - 90 Local & Global Missionaries Supported (\$15K/ mo)!
 - 21% Church Growth!
 - Partnered with 5 Adopted Neighborhood Schools!
 - 550 Jesus Loves Seattle Hope Bags Unleashed!

- 1) Dwell on the God of Hope (Jeremiah 29:11)
- 2) Cultivate Curiosity and Growth
- 3) Start <u>Dreaming</u> Again (Ephesians 3:20)
- 4) Smile

IV. GUILT

-How do we get free from the crippling emotion of guilt?

Ring the Bells of Jesus' Joy:

- 1) Identity: Live from a place of grace
 - "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." (Romans 8:1 NIV)
- 2) Boundary: Establish clear parameters i.e., Excellence vs Perfectionism
- 3) Vocabulary: Speak a new narrative

V. WORRY
