7 FUNDAMENTAL QUESTIONS FOR BECOMING MORE EFFECTIVE IN 2022

I. WILL I MAKE KEY <u>ATTITUDE DECISIONS</u> IN ADVANCE? YOUR ATTITUDE SHOULD BE THE SAME AS THAT OF CHRIST JESUS. Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death – even death on a cross! Philippians 2:5-8 NIV

HUMILITY 101: Offer your opinion and don't listen.

II. WILL I LIVE SELFLESSLY?

"In humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others." Philippians 2:3-4

"And he said to all, 'If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.'" Luke 9:23

III. WILL I SEEK <u>SELF-AWARENESS</u>?

"Don't pick on people, jump on their failures, criticize their faults – unless, of course, you want the same treatment. That critical spirit has a way of boomeranging. It's easy to see a smudge on your neighbor's face and be oblivious to the ugly sneer on your own. Do you have the nerve to say, 'Let me wash your face for you,' when your own face is distorted by contempt? It's this whole traveling road-show mentality all over again, playing a holier-than-thou part instead of just living your part. Wipe that ugly sneer off your own face, and you might be fit to offer a washcloth to your neighbor."

IV. WILL I STOP WHEN HEADED IN THE WRONG DIRECTION?

V. WILL I DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN HEALTHY HABITS?

Live in peace with each other. And we urge you, brothers and sisters, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone. Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else.
