5 WAYS JESUS INSPIRES CHILDLIKE CHANGE

I. WHO ARE YOU DEPENDING ON?

- How does the child provide nothing and yet everything is provided them?
- 100%, absolute, unceasing dependence
- "There is such a thing as having one's soul kept in perfect peace, now and here in this life; and CHILDLIKE TRUST IN GOD IS THE KEY to its attainment." Hannah Whitall Smith, *The Christian's* Secret of a Happy Life

II. DOES YOUR MIND NEED A <u>RESET</u>?

- "We are built for contemplation." Martin Laird, *Into The Silent Land: A Guide to the Christian Practice of Contemplation*
- You know your mind needs a reset if:
 - 1) You have a consciousness of need
 - 2) You have a supreme consciousness of helplessness
 - 3) You have contemplated the counsel of desperation
- Jesus

III. WILL YOU HUMBLY SURRENDER?

- "Who is the greatest?" Matthew 18:1
- "... Change and become like little CHILDREN..." Matthew 18:3
- Children don't ask to surrender; they assent to surrender.
