Going Deeper (questions for groups):

- 1. Isaiah has been called the prophet of hope. Read through this passage and circle the statements that you find especially hopeful (it might be every verse!).
- 2. Describe a physical setting that you have been in that comes the closest to the description in verses 1-2. What feelings do you associate with that place?
- 3. Tell us about a dry desert (metaphorically) that you have been in. Did God come to your aid? What did that look like?
- 4. What three physical characteristics are described in verses 3 and 4? What emotions do they represent? Which of them come closest to something you have been through lately? Tell us about it.
- 5. Why is fear such a dangerous enemy? In what ways do you deal with fear? How do these verses speak to you?
- 6. Describe the highway of holiness. What are the characteristics? List them. What does the metaphor of highway say to you? How does that metaphor speak into our current experience?
- 7. We talk about CCA being a hub of hope. How does this passage help us understand what this looks like?
